^{*} The current graduate in-state tuition rate is \$538.40 per credit hour. First-year graduate students enroll in 13 credit hours in the Fall semester and 13 credit hours in the Spring semester. Currently, first-year students receive a 9-month, 20 hour per week assistantship that includes a non-resident waiver for all tuition credits and tuition remission for up to 9 credits per semester. The assistantship also includes a total stipend of approximately \$16,622. Funding in future years is contingent on budgetary approval.
